
Why Am I Getting a Survey-Not-Found Page?

If you're seeing the below page it is likely because you made a change to your survey link and are still trying to access the old link.

	Survey not found
	The survey you are looking for was either moved or removed, or maybe the URL was entered incorrectly.
	Some things to try:
•	Check that the URL was entered correctly.
٠	Instead of clicking on the link, try copy and pasting the link instead.
٠	Contact the person/organization running the survey.
•	Submit a ticket to our Support Team.

For example, when you copy a survey, it will create a share link with the word *copy* in it. If you edit the link to remove the word *copy* and then try to access the old link, you will be taken to the *survey not found* page.

The same can happen when customizing your link to use a private domain or branded sub-domains. This is true for both web links and email campaign links.

🞓 Best Practice Tip

We recommend creating a new link and then applying customizations. This way you won't have to worry about sharing a link that no longer works.

To create a new link, simply click the **Create New Tracking Link** button towards the bottom of the **Share** tab. Give your new link a name, and click **Edit this link** to apply your customizations.

This will create a new link with your private domain. This way, if you shared your default link during testing it will continue to work along with your new private domain link.
